ABOUT THREE-DAY EVENTING

Eventing is a thrilling equestrian sport that involves a rider working with a horse both on the flat and over fences. The three phases, dressage, cross-country, and show jumping, keep spectators on the edge of their seats with the mix of beauty, elegance, and pure power displayed by horse and rider. Over the centuries it has developed from the test of the ideal military charger into an exciting sport that attracts interest from all levels of enthusiasts, from weekend hobby riders to professional international stars.



The purpose of the dressage test is to demonstrate the level of communication between the horse and rider and to display the power and grace required to perform each movement with balance, rhythm, and suppleness.



The cross-country phase includes 24 to 36 fixed and solid obstacles over a course of up to 4 miles over varied terrain, designed to challenge horse and rider to their limits. The cross-country phase requires horse and rider to be bold and smart while testing their physical stamina.



The show jumping course is comprised of a series of fences in an arena, made up of rails that are easily knocked down. This final jumping phase tests the stamina and recovery of the horse, demonstrating that it is fit enough to continue competing at peak performance.

ABOUT SYNDICATION



Horse ownership syndication is where a group of supporters come together to purchase shares in a promising horse for a professional Event rider. The syndicate is comprised of shares purchased by each member of the group. These shares are an investment in both the initial purchase of the horse and the annual expenses incurred to maintain and compete the horse.

Jennifer started her riding career in Pony Club and showed her family's Morgan horses on a regional and national level, winning many national titles in Hunter Pleasure, Western Pleasure, Dressage and Jumping. She and Kublahan, a Morgan gelding and her partner during her teenage years, are pictured on the cover of the Pony Club "A" manual and had an exciting career together. Her early years as a trainer/instructor earned her recognition on the national level and the Morgan Horse Association honored her for her influence on the Morgan breed, particularly in the area of Eventing. Currently, she and High Times, a Holsteiner gelding she has brought up through the levels, are achieving noteworthy success at the top levels of Eventing. Together the pair have finished in the top 10 at multiple CIC3* and CCI3* events and have successfully completed their first CCI4* together.

Billy, a 2004 Holsteiner gelding, is a true superstar in every sense of the word. He has incredible natural talent and ability and a great love for his job, attracting fans everywhere he goes. With interationally successful relatives like La Biosthetique Sam, Butts Leon, and FRH Butts Abraxxas, it is clear that Billy has not yet reached his full potential. Billy has had a very successful career with Jennifer thus far, beginning in 2009 and racking up top placings as he moved up the levels. He first contested the Advanced level in 2013, and shortly thereafter placed 6th in his first CIC3* at Galway Downs. Together he and Jennifer successfully contested their first CCI4* at the Rolex Kentucky Three Day Event in 2014. This incredibly talented horse is only just getting started!

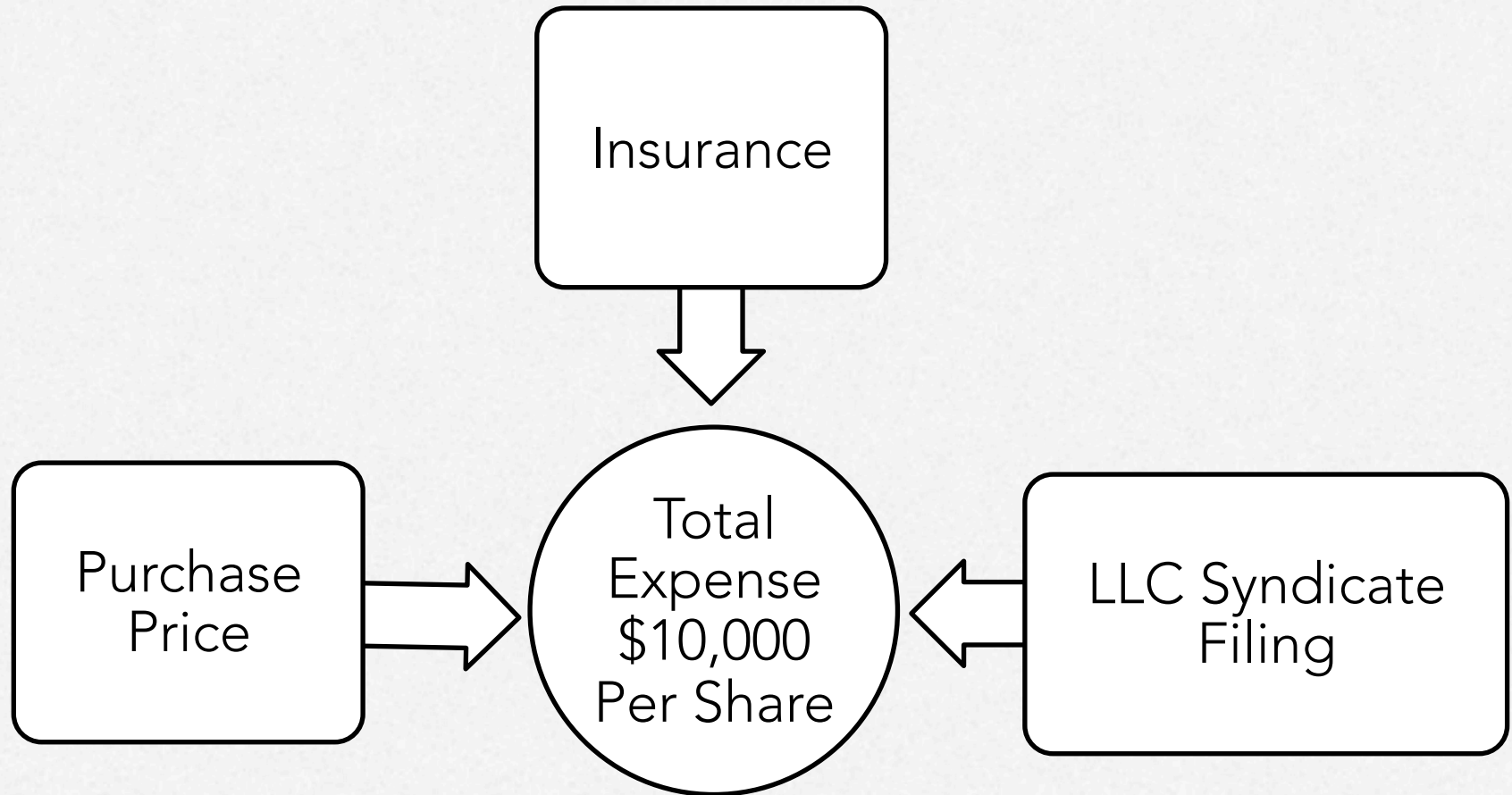

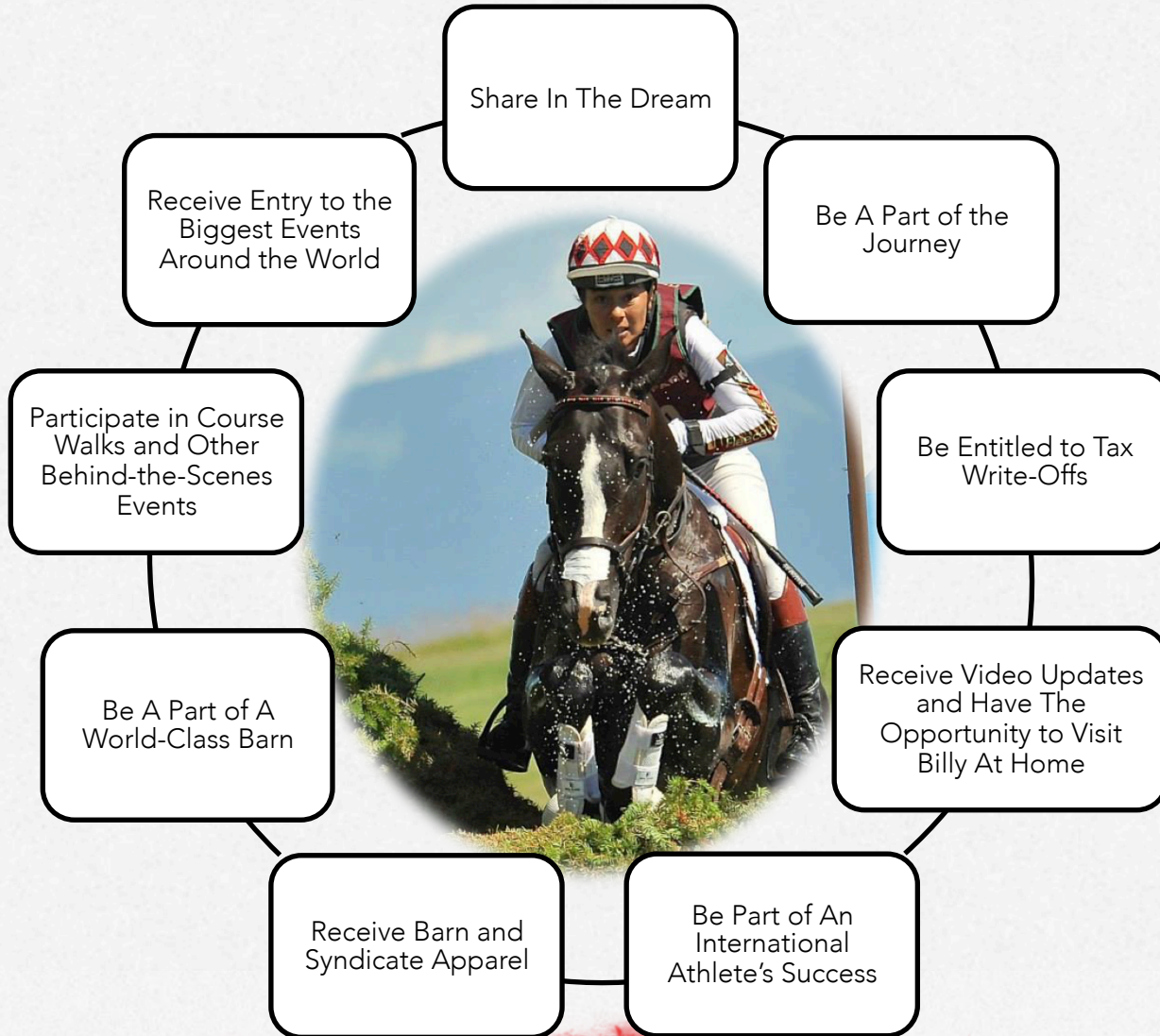
